

## Proposed 5 Standing Committees

Each committee supports the goals of our local party and maintains a consistent base level support for all endorsed candidates. Committee Co-chairs are planners who coordinate volunteers to help with the work. The Co-chairs are voting members of the Executive Committee. Committees meet as necessary.

### 1. Candidate Committee Co-chairs

Goal/Results: Find, support, and coordinate with candidates.

- a. Interview candidates seeking endorsement (Candidate Interview Committee)
- b. Assist applicants seeking election to the Executive Committee and delegate positions (Applicant Filling Committee)
- c. Coordinate Party and candidate participation in parades
- d. Maintain the float
- e. Provide a manual to assist candidates
- f. Maintain a candidate inventory database

### 2. Conventions Committee Co-chairs

Goal/Results: Provide the means to involve Republicans and endorse candidates.

- a. Manage precinct caucuses
- b. Manage all conventions
- c. Track convention delegate attendance
- d. Conduct candidate forums prior to endorsing conventions
- e. Assist Election Judge and Poll Challenger volunteers

### 3. Elections Committee Co-chairs

Goal/Results: Provide the data and support to elect Republicans.

- a. Coordinate Voter ID work
- b. Maintain lists and use Datacenter
- c. Recruit yard sign locations
- d. Coordinate sign installation and removal

### 4. Fundraising Committee Co-chairs

Goal/Results: Provide the financial resources to support party goals and candidates.

- a. Manage the Reagan Day Dinner
- b. Conduct fundraising events
- c. Raise funds from individuals
- d. Propose a budget

### 5. Public Relations Committee Co-chairs

Goal/Results: Provide information to support activities and candidates.

- a. Maintain the website
- b. Make posts on the website
- c. Use social media
- d. Coordinate a LTE program
